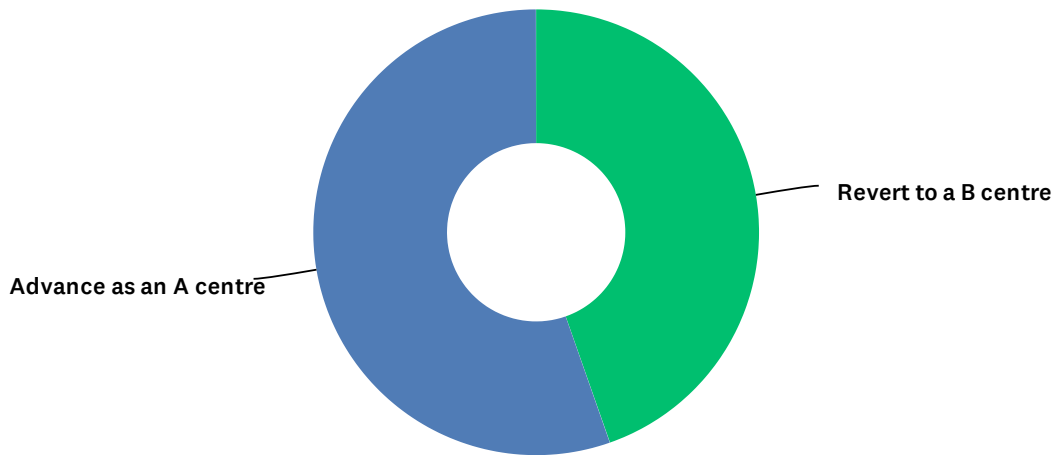

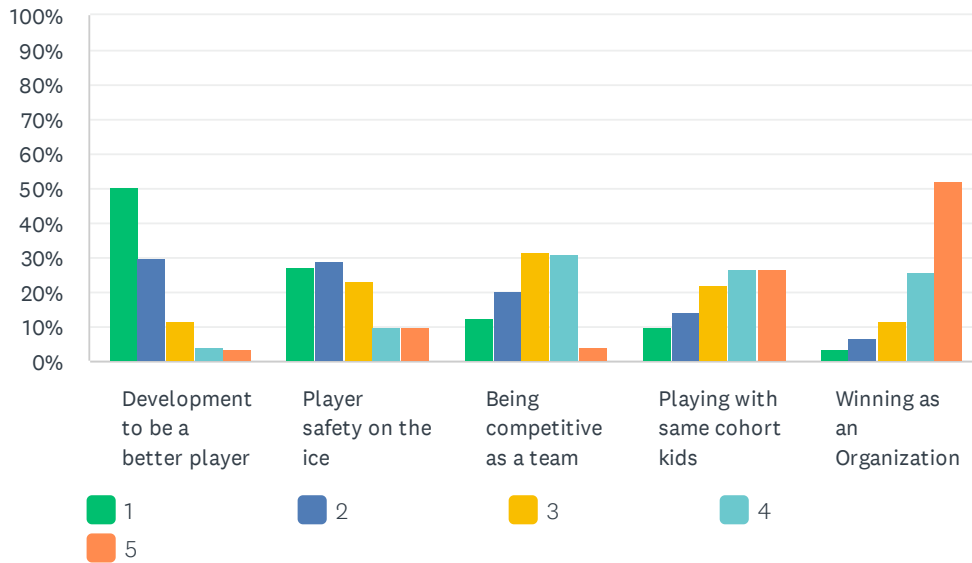

Q2 For your child in minor hockey, please rank in order of importance the following items? (1 being most important, 5 being least important)

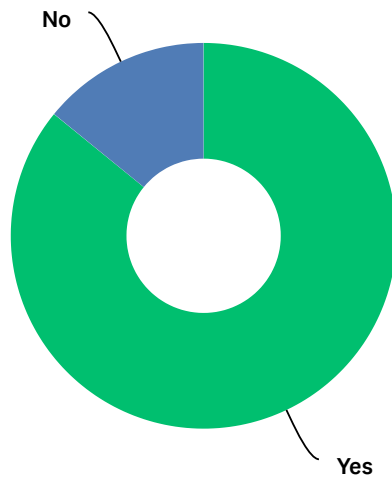

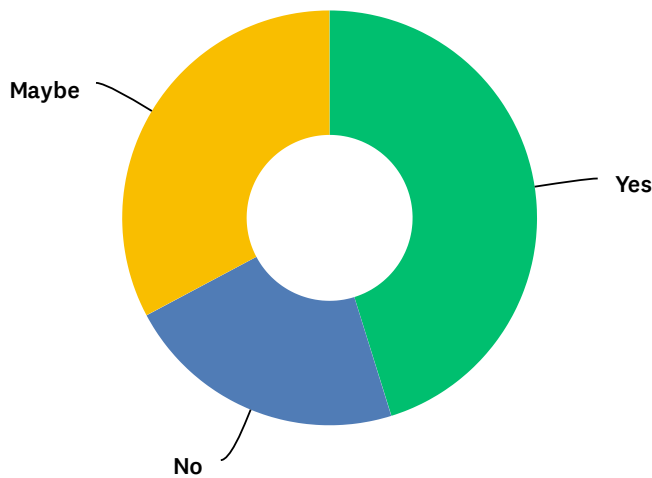

Q4 Do you feel the Mixed-Cohort system allows for better socialization of players of all ages?

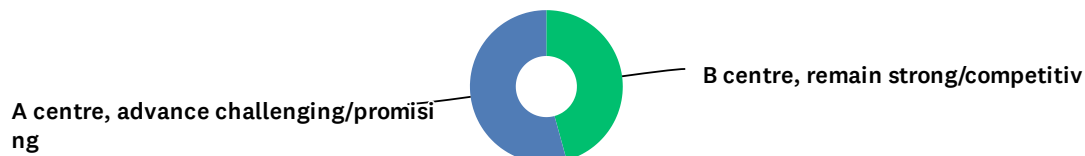

Q5 Do you feel it is better to remain a strong/competitive B centre or advance as a challenging/promising A centre?

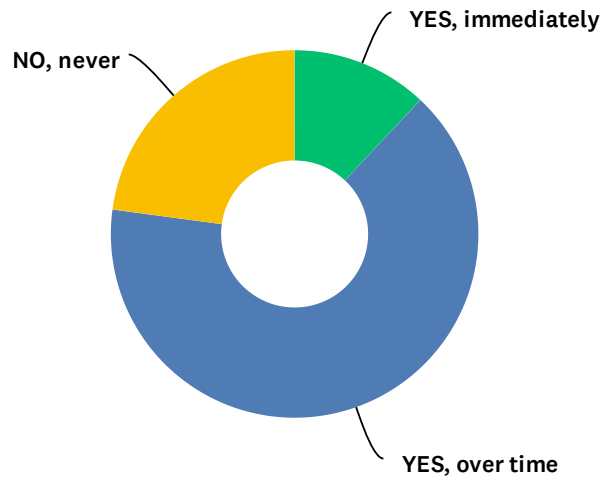

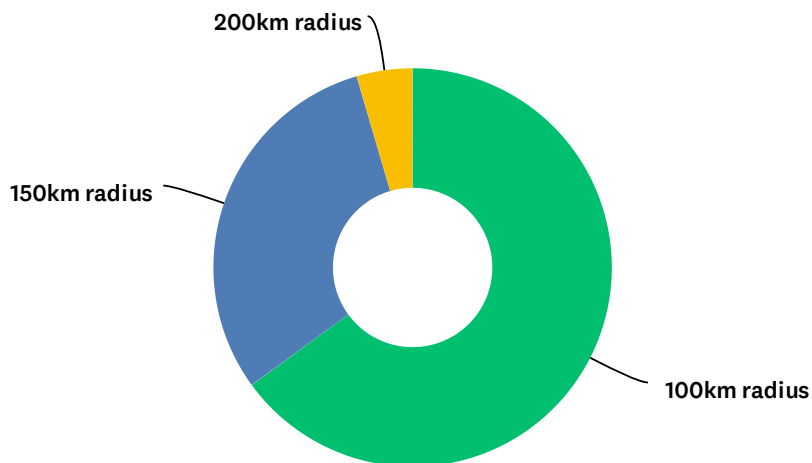

Q7 What is your preferred limitation on travel radius for representative hockey (1 way only) for regular season games?

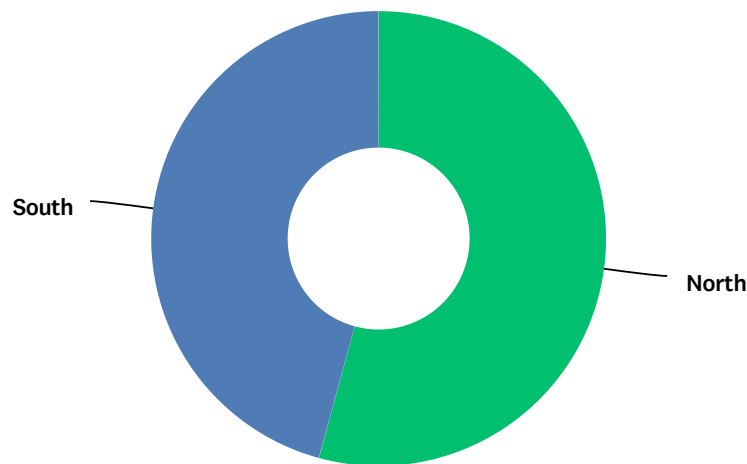

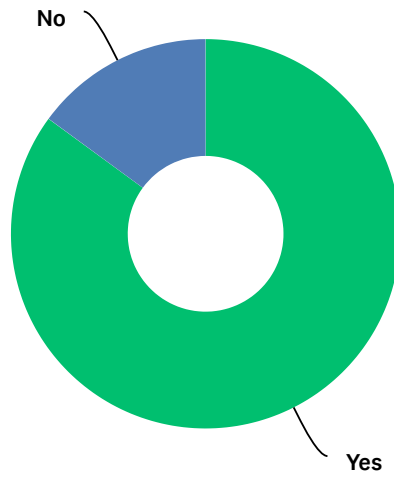

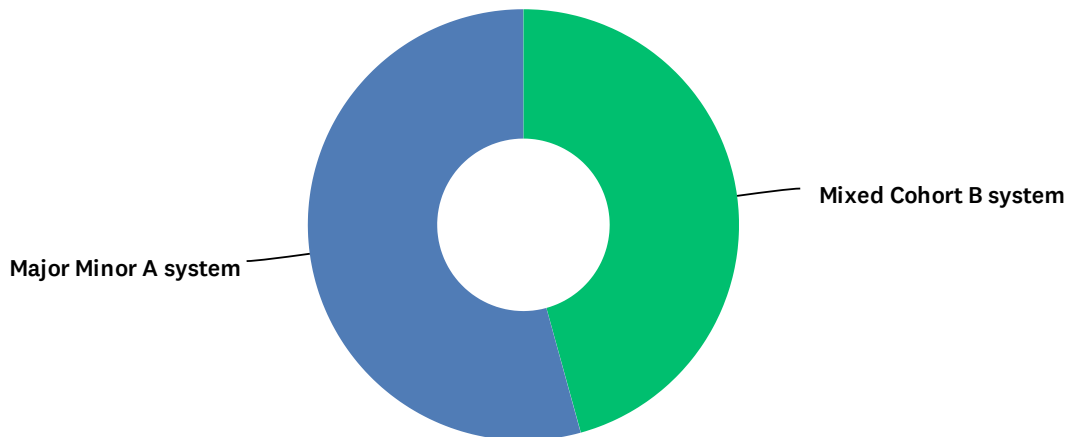

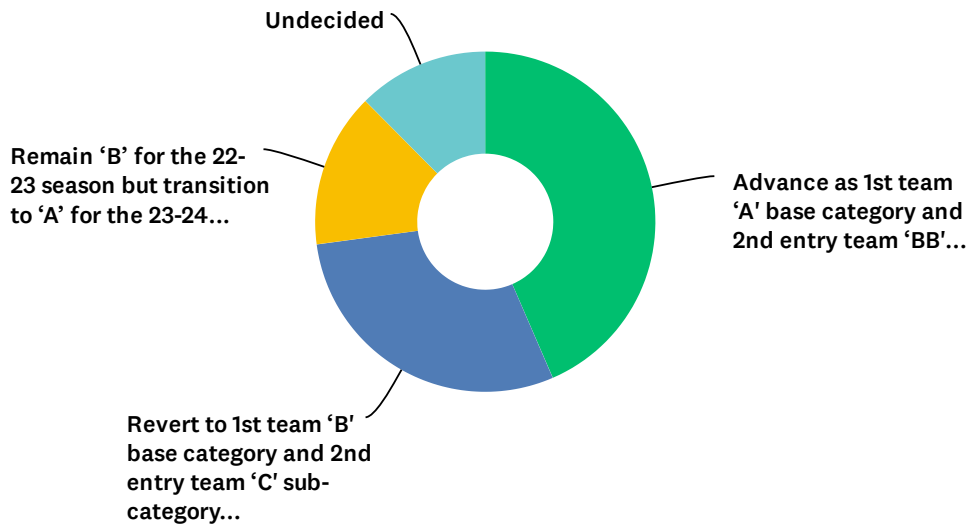
